Overview

Trinity Place will be a community of 73 affordable homes designed for formerly unhoused seniors age 55+, including individuals with disabilities. The development will revitalize an underutilized site with a new residential community that will help alleviate the City's need for supportive housing for our most vulnerable neighbors. Residents will benefit from a combination of high-quality, secure homes and support services designed to help them use housing as a platform for stability and health.

Description

- 73 studio apartments with contemporary design and function (plus 1 two-bedroom manager's unit)
- 18 apartments set aside for seniors with a diagnosed serious mental illness
- 30% AMI or lower; all apartments have Project-Based Section 8
- Common areas and community room to host beneficial programs, foster resident connections and promote sense of security for seniors
- Onsite property manager to maintain quality building operations

Supportive Services

Provided by People Assisting the Homeless (PATH) and St. Paul's Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) and tailored to the individual needs of residents, including:

- Dedicated case management
- Resident Service coordination
- Physical and mental health care
- Other services as needed
